★ Swim Across America St. Louis is a local, all-volunteer organization that raises money to fund cutting edge research and clinical trials at Siteman Cancer Center. SAA's scientific advisory committee of renowned cancer MDs and PHDs help us select projects and researchers who are the pioneers to curing cancer, and provide seed money to the projects that present the best opportunities for a breakthrough.

★ Our beneficiaries have reported that for every \$1 they receive from SAA, they are able to secure \$3 in new funding they might not otherwise have received. Locally, the SAA-funded clinical trial at

Siteman for pancreatic cancer patients resulted in approval of an additional \$2.8 million in direct and indirect funds.

★ The funds raised here stay here. 100% of each SAA grant must be applied to the approved clinical trial or research project.

★ Nationally, Swim Across America has raised more than \$110 million for cancer research and clinical trials at the nation's top cancer research institutions and played a major role in clinical funding of all four FDA approved immunotherapy drugs.

Melissa Reimers, MD PROJECT GOAL: To evaluate the safety and efficacy of therapies in reducing tumor burden in high-risk localized prostate cancer patients before radical prostatectomy.



Nusayba A. Bagegni, MD PROJECT GOAL: Phase II study to further research prospective trials for breast cancer patients to validate the clinical utility of PAM50 subtyping and personalized treatment selection in ER+/HER2-BC, particularly for Black patients.



Neha Mehta-Shah, MD PROJECT GOAL: Phase I Study for patients with Cutaneous T-cell lymphomas (CTCL) to understand the mechanisms of response and resistance to EZH2 Inhibitor CPI-0209 (Tulmimetostat) and provide insight into future combined therapies.

PROJECT GOAL:
To reduce the number of required post-lumpectomy radiation treatments for breast cancer patients by determining whether just one treatment of Accelerated Partial Breast Irradiation is as safe and effective as the fivetreatment standard of care.



Mark Schroeder, MD PROJECT GOAL: To explore whether blood cancer patients who receive blood or marrow transplants experience less Graft versus Host Disease when given baricitinib.



RESEARCH MILESTONE! Dr. David DeNardo received philanthropic funding from Swim Across America - St. Louis in 2020. The project goal was to test whether a novel combination therapy in PDAC patients will prime the patient's immune system to attack cancer cells and drive tumor protective immunity during and after pancreas cancer surgery.

Early findings from Dr. DeNardo's Swim Across America study were promising and positioned him to expand his research with a \$2.8 million grant from the National Cancer Institute at the National Institutes of Health (NIH). Click to read about Dr. DeNardo's NIH grant.
